## What is a Birth Doula?

A Doula...

- Recognizes childbirth as a key life experience that the mother will remember all her life
- Understands the physiology of birth and the emotional needs of a woman in labor
- Assists the woman and her partner in preparing for and carrying out their plans for birth
- Stays by the side of the laboring woman throughout the labor
- Provides emotional support, physical comfort measures and an objective viewpoint
- Helps the woman get the information she needs to make thoughtful decisions, both before and during labor
- Works to nurture and protect the woman's memory of her birth experience

## The Doula's Role

A Doula is not a medical practitioner. Doulas do not give medical advice. Doulas are trained in massage, breathing and other comfort techniques to help cope with labor. Through touch, praise, reassurance, and guidance, a Doula works to keep the mother and partner relaxed and focused.



## Doulas and Dads

Doulas are not a replacement for the special support dads or partners provide. They supplement and nurture this role by encouraging participation of dads or partners at their own comfort level. Doulas work to keep communication strong and focus on the whole family. A Doula provides reassurance and perspective to both the laboring woman and her partner.



## Vision Statement

To be a Doula is to work harmoniously with a woman to achieve a positive birth experience.

We believe in supporting women in their choices for childbirth. We help women grow in confidence during their pregnancy by listening to them and showing respect for their culture, beliefs, ideas, and customs.

To be a Doula is to engage in a close relationship with a pregnant woman which may only last a few weeks, but the effects of which travel down through the centuries in the image women have of themselves, their abilities and their worth.
